- While all OJT in person skills training is on hold during the Shelter in Place mandate, we can assist you with completing your employer paperwork now.



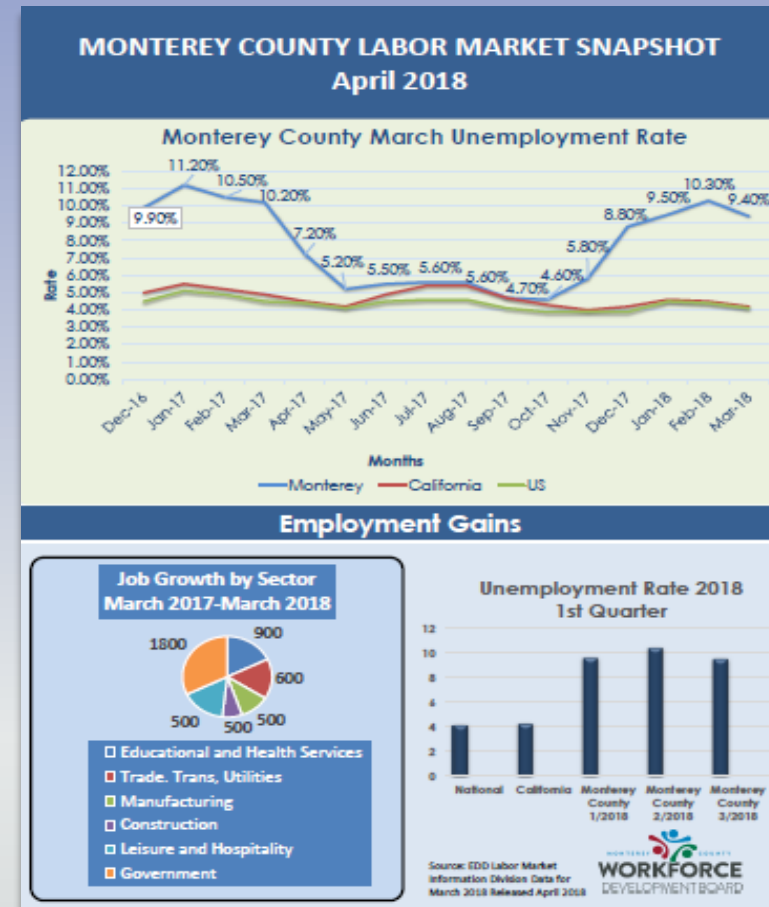

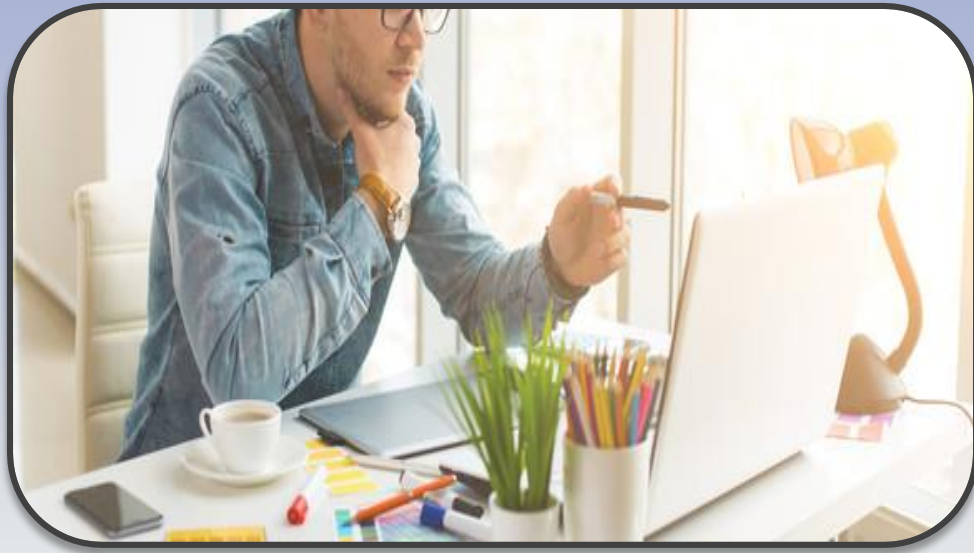
